





 Transaction formats (validate dates, mandatory fields, etc.)

2. Validation rules
(contract associated with specimen plan, SIN must exist in CDSP system, etc.)

# **Errors**

(sent in the RT 801 file)

3. CDSG and CDSB payment validation (age of beneficiary, annual and lifetime payment limits, etc.)

CRA-BPD (residency, DTC, income)







#### 8102 Is not identified in the CDSP system

#### 8105

Invalid SIN

One or more of the following five fields of the SIN information did not pass validation requirements:

- SIN
- given name
- surname
- date of birth
- sex

**RESOLUTION:** Ensure that the SIN information provided by the holder matches the data that was submitted. The CDSP system validates the SIN information with the Social Insurance Register (SIR).

Consult the error file (RT 801) for information on which of the five fields have failed SIR validation. If necessary, contact the holder to validate the information (including spelling).

If the data originally submitted appears to be correct, refer the holder to the SIR to verify the information that they have on record.

# Appendix A: Understanding error codes (8102)

#### 8102

Is not identified in the CDSP system A record was submitted with a field that cannot be matched with existing data in the CDSP system. This error code applies to most transaction records that require matching with data associated to an existing contract.

The following fields can be affected by this error code:

- the issuer BN
- the specimen plan
- the beneficiary and holder Social Insurance Number (SIN) information
- the contract number

**RESOLUTION:** Ensure that the data corresponds to data previously validated by the CDSP system for the existing RDSP.

#### **Description**

The beneficiary is not established in the CDSP system

#### Resolution

Establish the beneficiary and re-submit transactions






